

TEA PARTY EXPRESS II STOPS IN DENVER

As the Tea Party Express II buses were making their way across the nation, they made a stop on Tuesday November 3, 2009 at the Civic Center Greek Theatre downtown Denver. It was reported by the Colorado 9.12 Leadership Team that approximately 2500 people were in attendance.

The national tour bus group made quite a grand entrance parading into the Greek Theatre with the majority carrying signs. The cheering of the crowd charged up the weary TPXII group who had traveled thousands of miles on these buses and had already made twenty one stops prior to Denver.

"Joe The Plumber" told Denver ralliers that he "was proud to be an American" and "not ashamed to be a Christian". He also told the crowd to not be proud of themselves just for attending the Tea Party that evening, but to make an effort to stay involved and be active in changing the direction of this country. Joe was a straight-from-the-heart style speaker and was quite moving. The crowd was

totally energized by his words. He was generous in his time spent with individuals and allowing photo opportunities.

Most of the 2,500 rally attendees carried signs with messages about increased government spending, increased national debt, adherence to the constitution, and the steering toward socialism. The primary focus of the evening, however, was on the recently proposed H.R. 3962.

A highlight of the event was copies of the 1,990 page bill being passed through the crowd and then everyone simultaneously tore them into pieces by hand. These pieces were then placed into nine boxes; one each for Senators Udall and Bennet and the seven Colorado Congressional District Representatives. Along with the torn up pieces, there were letters stating that the proposed H.R. 3962 was unacceptable and they should tear it up and start over. Also, letters from the audience were placed in the boxes as well as signed petitions against the proposed bill. These boxes were then delivered by liberty loving patriots to each of the Senators' and Congressional Representatives' local offices on Thursday 11/5/09 coinciding with the national "Emergency House Call on Congress" in Washington as initiated by Michelle Bachmann.
